Cumberland**Total Trust Funds Granted:****\$12,327,806****Description of a recent project:****2005 The Cape Fear River Trail and River Oaks Preserve**

Every day, more than 300 people bike and walk the City of Fayetteville's Cape Fear River Trail, funded in part by a \$250,000 grant from the Parks and Recreation Trust Fund and a \$1.2 million grant from the Federal Transportation Enhancement funds. An additional \$289,000 grant from the Clean Water Management Trust Fund will be combined with local and federal funds to extend the popular trail. When complete, the trail will run along the Cape Fear River from Methodist College to the Cape Fear Botanical Gardens, past several special places that highlight the surprising beauty of the river in this area. North of this trail, the Sandhills Area Land Trust is establishing a new flagship nature preserve that boasts steep ravines, high bluffs, majestic hardwoods, and a flowing waterfall. Clean Water Management Trust Fund grants totaling \$983,000 helped make the purchase possible, and through the educational outreach programs of the Sandhills Area Land Trust, the public will have the opportunity to visit this amazing place in the future.
