Description of a recent project:**2005 Clean Water, History, and Nature on the Haw River**

When trust fund money was invested, Alamance County made substantial headway on implementing a plan to improve water quality and protect important historic sites, forests, and farms along the Haw River. The Clean Water Management Trust Fund and the Tobacco Trust Fund Commission gave three grants totaling \$502,000 to help protect a 370-acre tobacco, cattle and strawberry farm and to create local parks at Glencoe Mill and at Carolina Mill, two important historic sites on the river. When open, these two parks will also serve as important links in the statewide Mountains-to-Sea Trail.
