

## Billion Dollar Land Deal

No one would argue they're worth a lot, but a billion dollars? You may be asked that question on this fall's ballot.

A group called "Land for Tomorrow" is trying to get support from citizens and lawmakers. They want this billion dollars to come from a bond issue, \$200 million each year for five years. This week, the Burlington City Council passed a resolution supporting the idea.

The money would protect open space, clean water and historic places in North Carolina. Local supporters would like to get money for Mayodan State Park, Randleman Reservoir and the Haw River. State lawmakers will look over the issue later this year, and decide whether you'll get to vote on it this fall.
